

PHLEBOTOMISTS

Main Function: To draw blood from patients or donors of all ages in hospital, blood bank or similar facility for analysis or other medical purposes.

Education:

- High school diploma or equivalent required
- Phlebotomy Certification from an accredited agency or an approved phlebotomy training course or experience through previous employment
- Medical training helpful (medical assistant, paramedical)

Minimum Requirements:

- Minimum of three years of past work experience as a Phlebotomist in a variety of settings.
- Three verifiable employment references
- Current Healthcare Provider CPR certification.
- Current physical and 2 step PPD or chest X-ray.
- Proof of hepatitis shots, initiation of shots or declination letter.
- Proof of MMR and Varicella immunization/titre.
- Must possess excellent communication, organizational and public relation skills.
- Able to successfully work independently
